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Nursery enjoyed our sports coach visit this week!

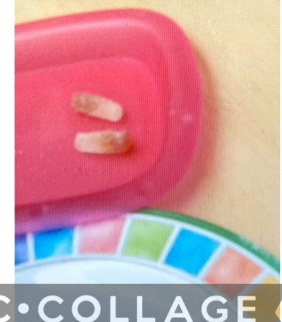
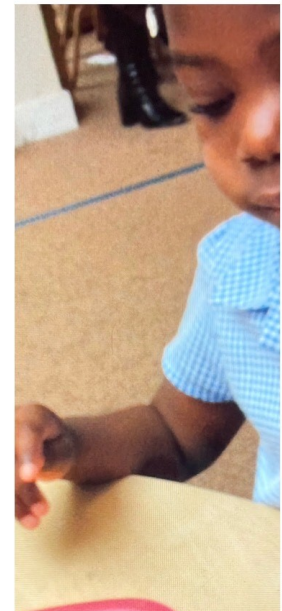


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This week reception have been using sweets to look at doubling, sharing and odd and even numbers! What yummy maths!



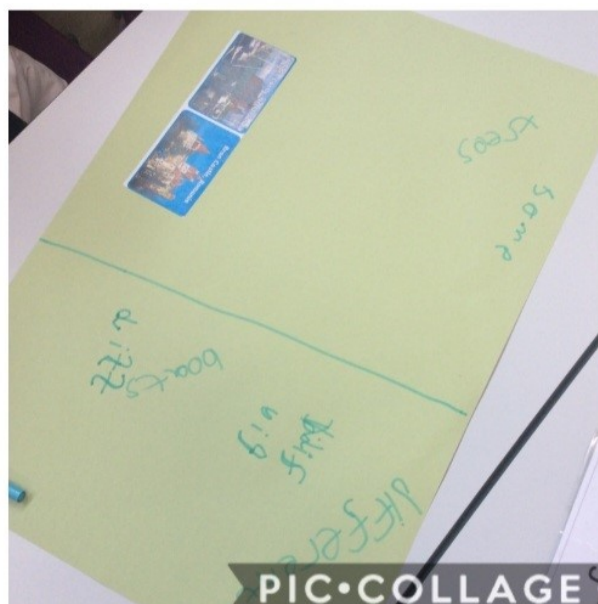
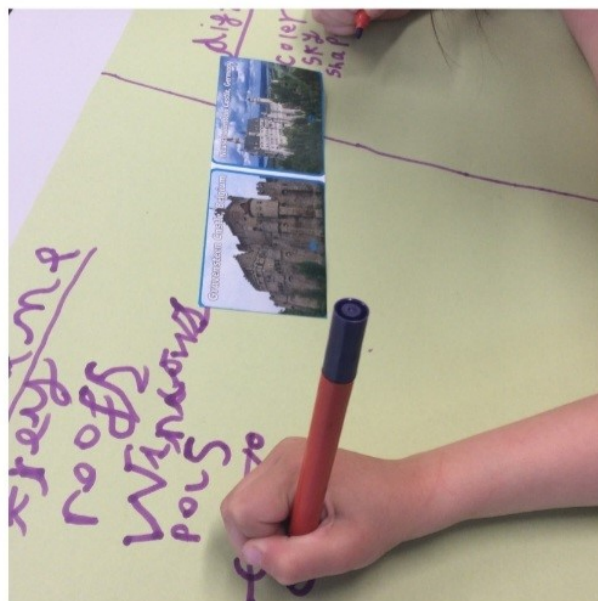
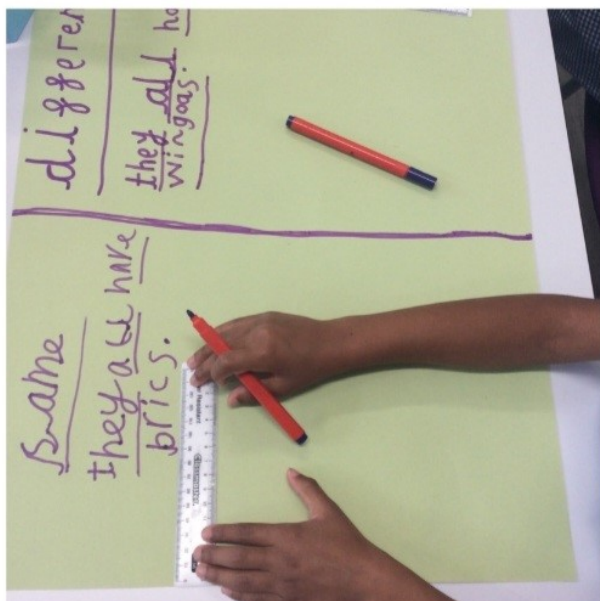

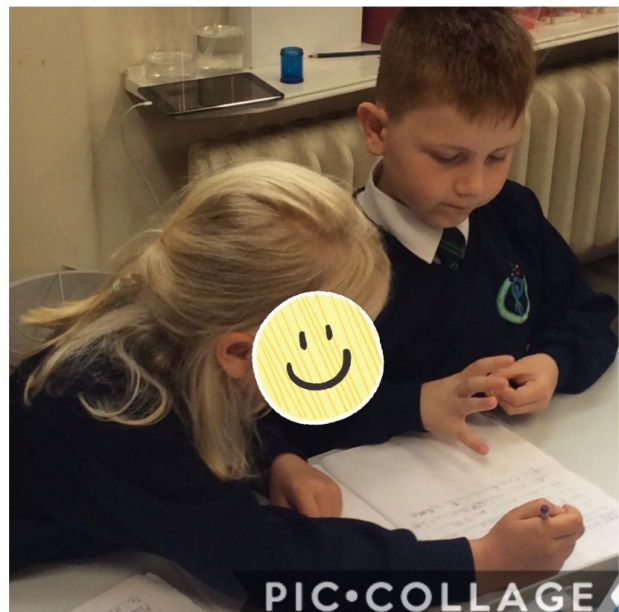
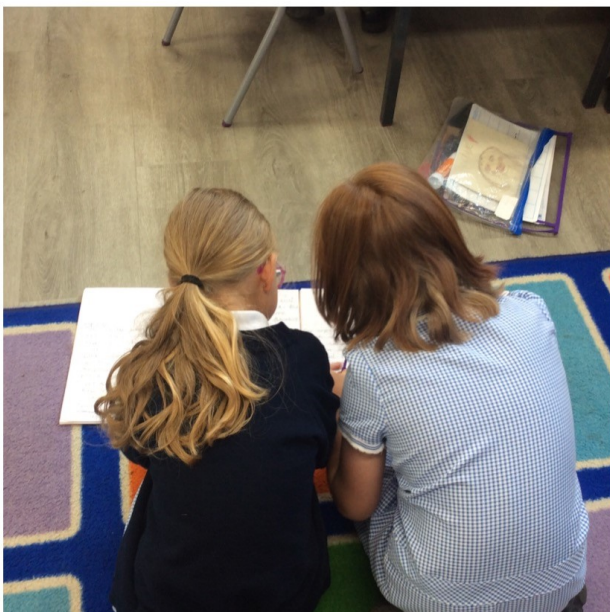
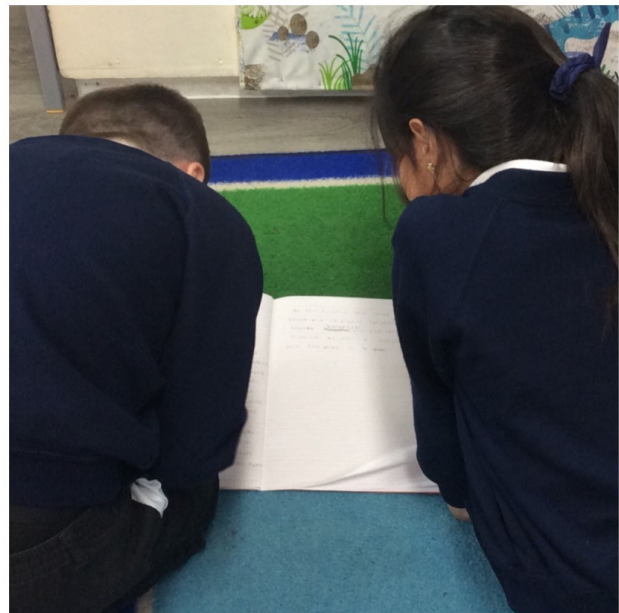
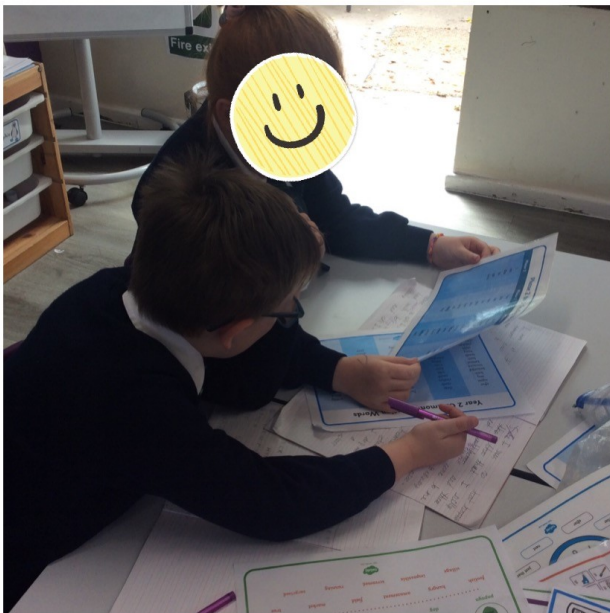


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In Darwin Class this week we have been learning to improve our writing by editing. Today we also did some peer editing. The children worked really well together.

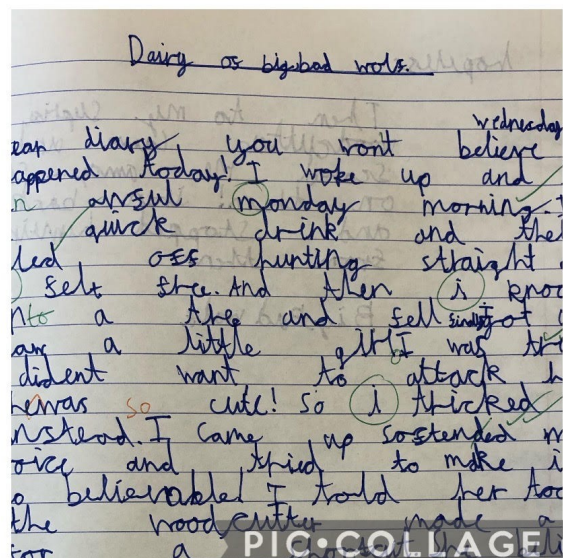
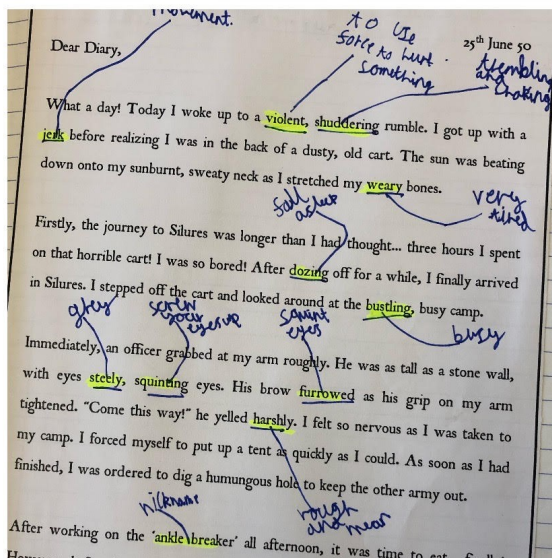
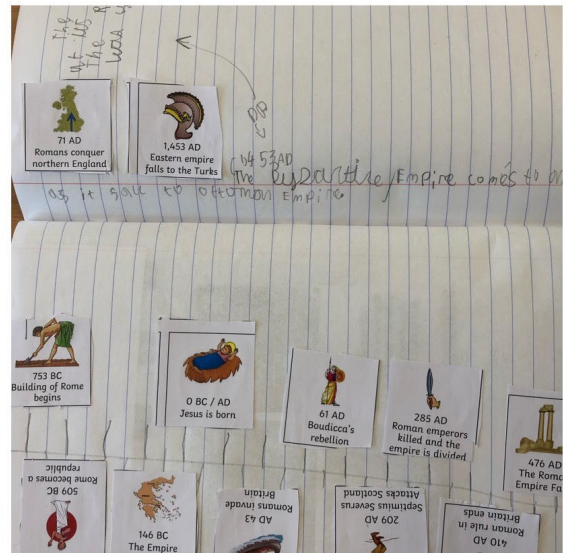


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## Head Teacher to Home - 10th June What has happened in school this week?

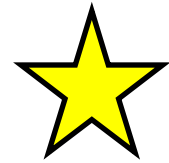




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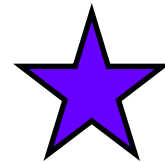
