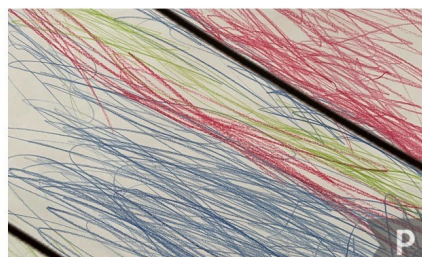
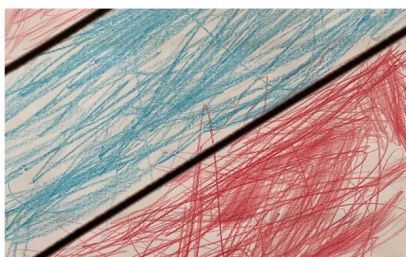

We have also learnt about Sir Francis Beaufort and used his Beaufort scale to decide how strong the wind was.



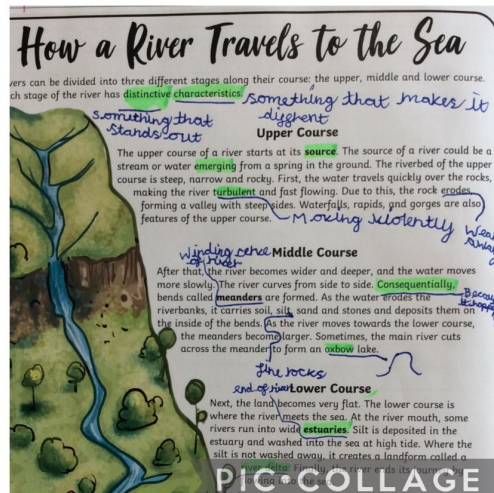
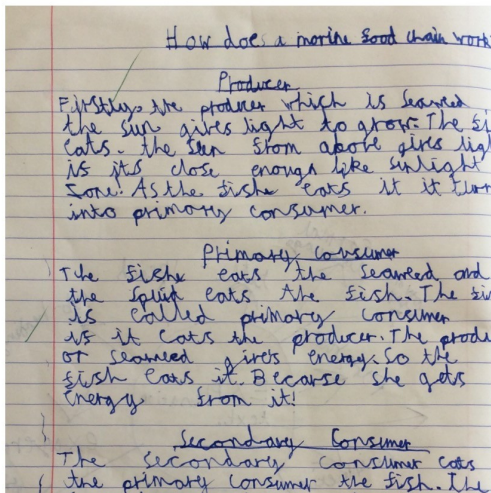
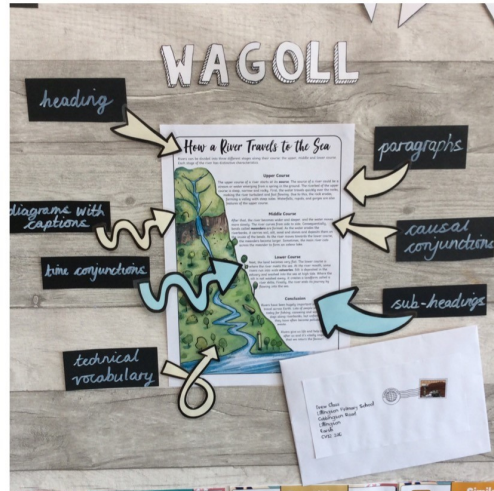

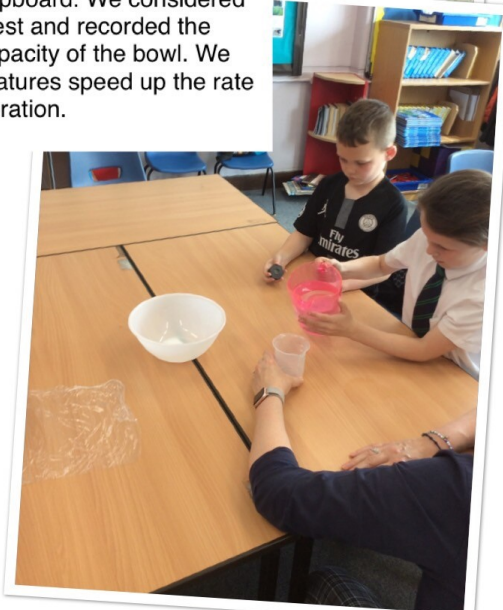
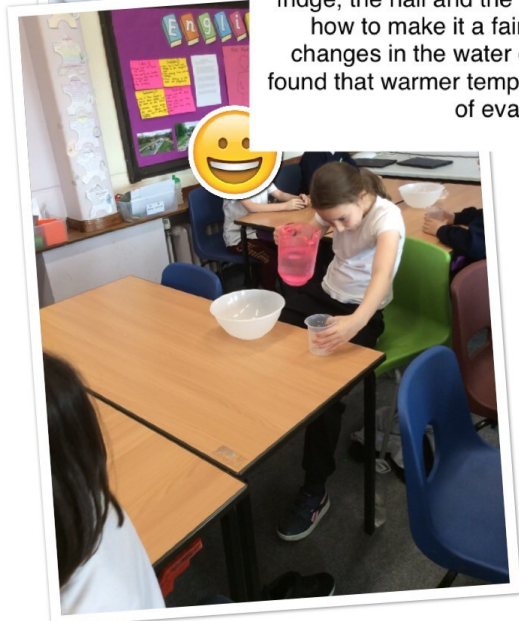
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## Head Teacher to Home - 20th May What has happened in school this week?



Hopper class have been investigating how temperature affects the rate of evaporation. We decided to set up 5 different water cycles and place them in different areas that are warmer and cooler. We chose- outside, the windowsill, the fridge, the hall and the cupboard. We considered how to make it a fair test and recorded the changes in the water capacity of the bowl. We found that warmer temperatures speed up the rate of evaporation.



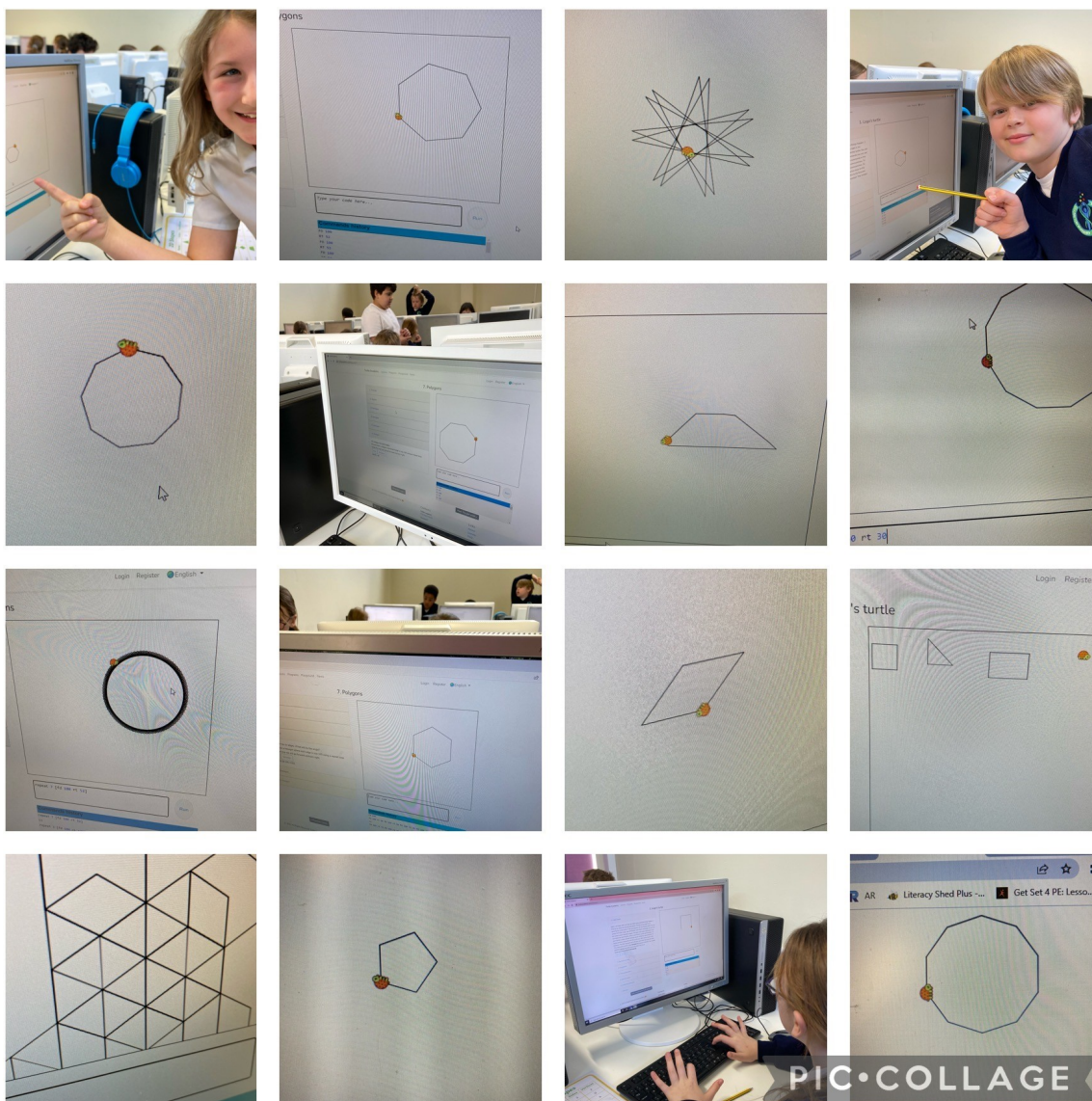

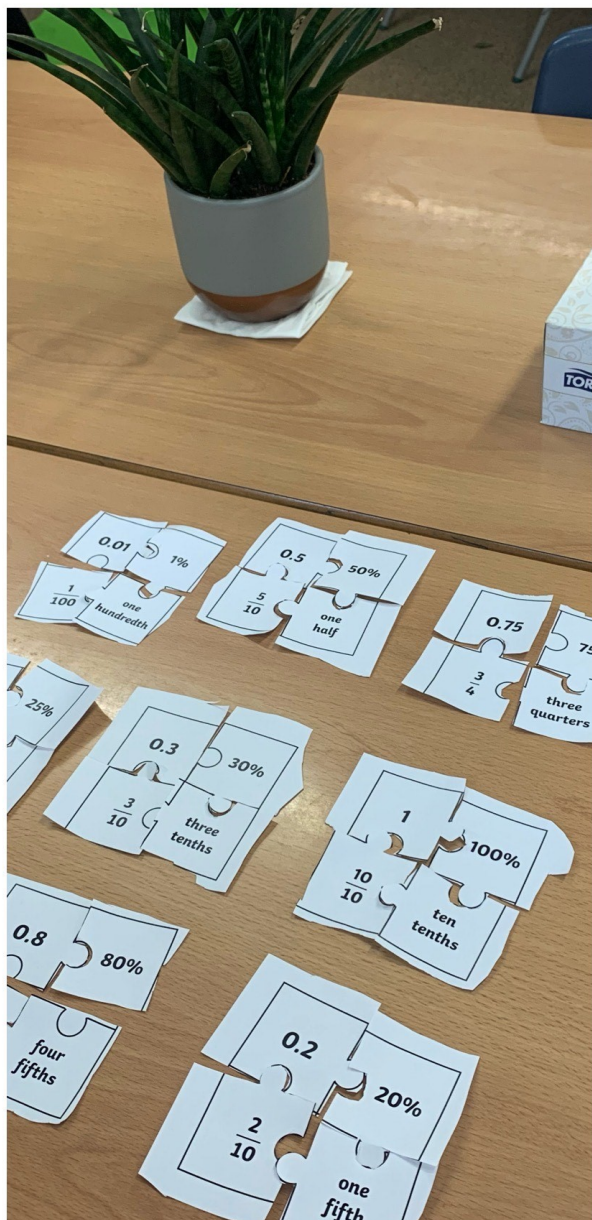

Pankhurst have loved completing a fractions, decimals and percentages puzzle in maths. They have demonstrated excellent teamwork skills. Well done Pankhurst.





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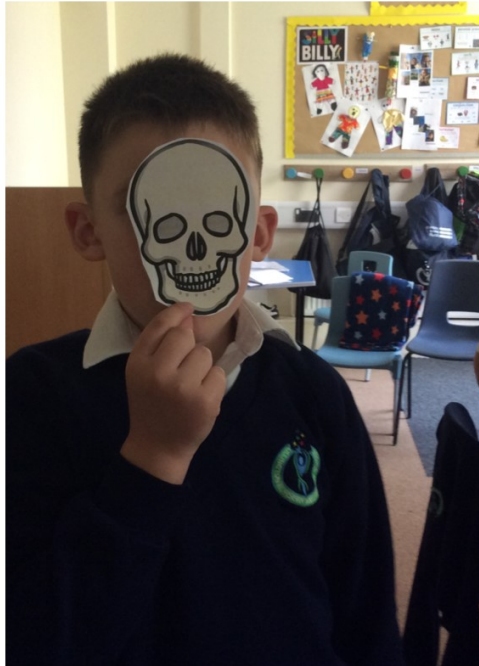

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In Maple we're learning about skeletons. We made a moving funny bones, matched bones to our bodies and shook hands with a boneless hand.



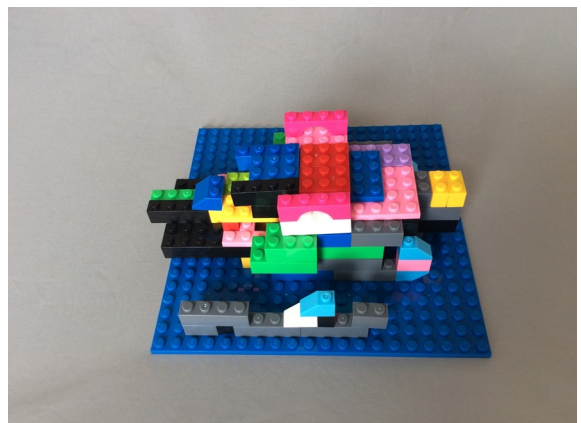
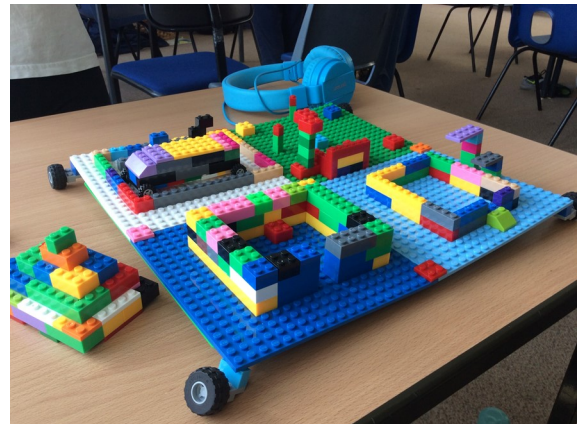
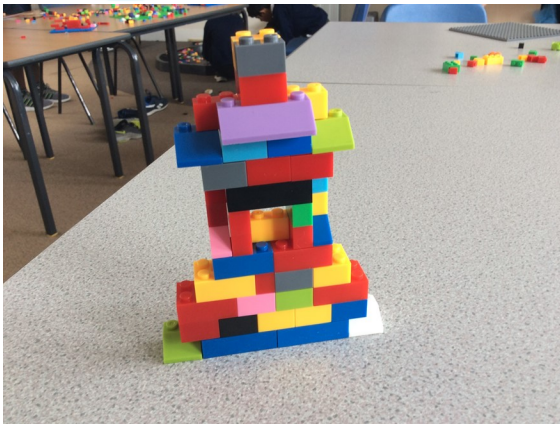
