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Reception have made a beautiful crown to celebrate the Queen's extraordinary life and reign.

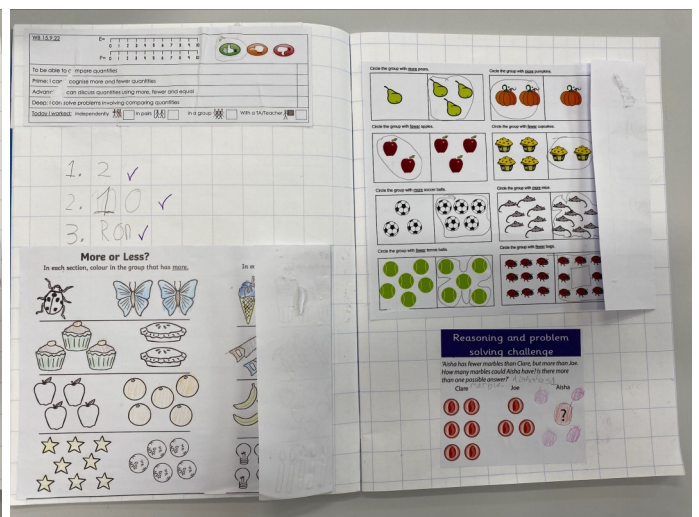
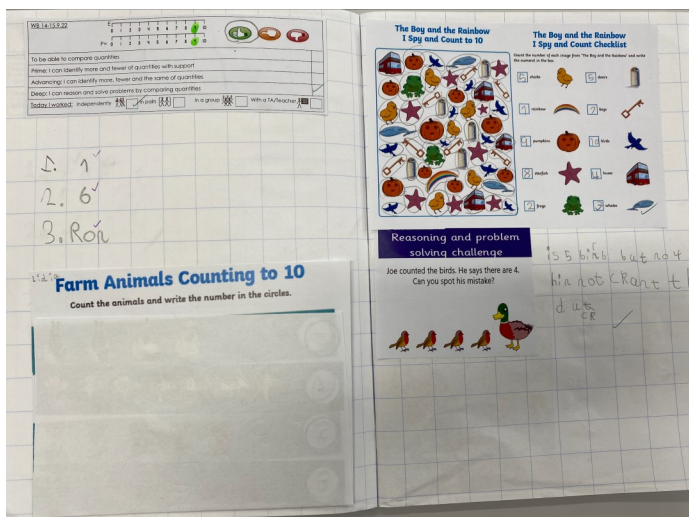
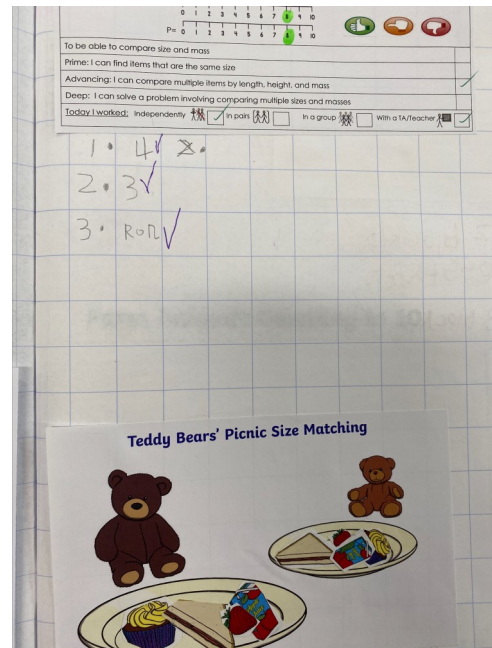
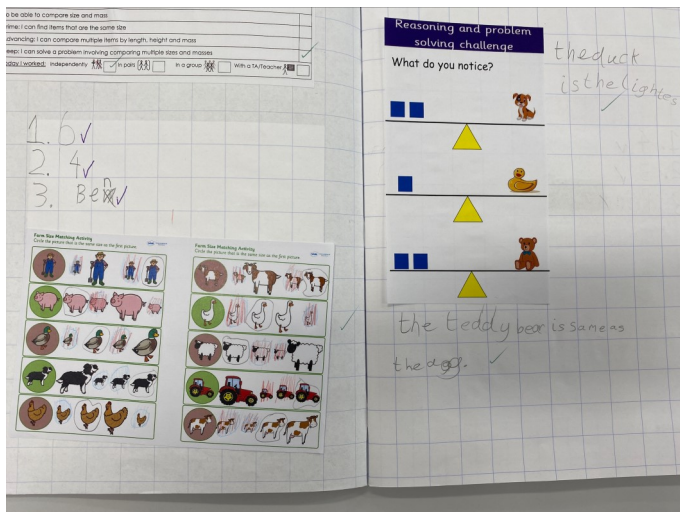

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This week, Drew class started their D&T topic by thinking all about how to categorise food into their groups. They discussed how much of each food group is healthiest to eat and how we can identify different foods.

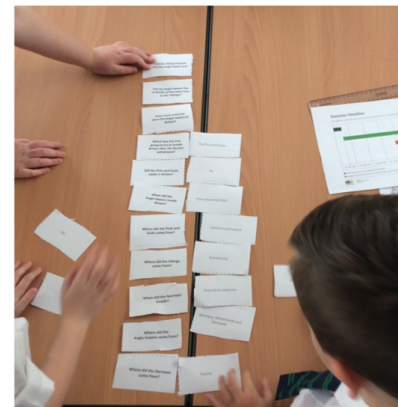
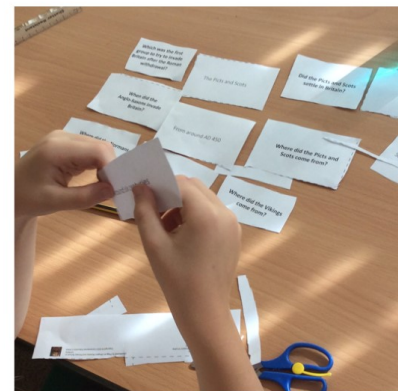
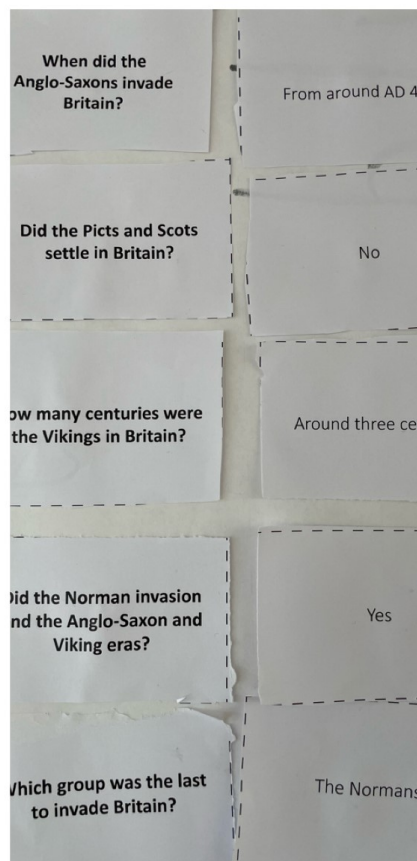
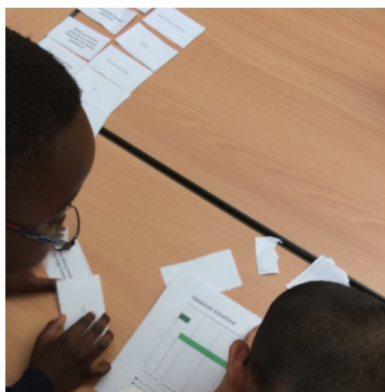
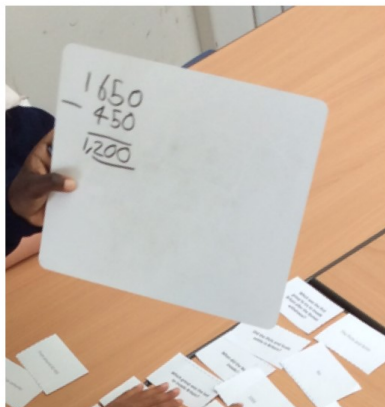
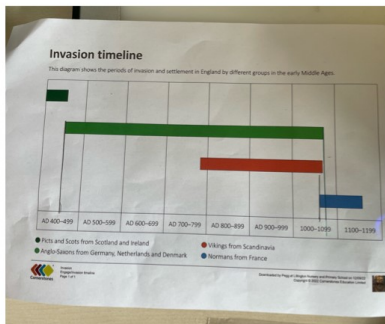


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Year 4 have had an excellent first full week at school. We have enjoyed looking at a variety of timelines in History this week.
