This will ensure we will be in line with national expectations for Primary schools. I know the children will rise to this challenge and it would be amazing to see us hit that target on a regular basis.









Head Teacher to Home - 21st October What has happened in school this week?


If your child has sickness or diarrhoea, it is a Public Health requirement that they must stay off school for 48 hours after the last occurrence.


