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







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In Peake Class this week, we have been looking at flexible partitioning. The children worked hard to use tens and ones to represent numbers in different ways.











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This week, Drew practiced their food preparation skills by cutting various fruits. They made sure to double check their food safety (particularly keeping their fingers out of the way)!












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Year 4 had fun this week making timelines linked to the topic Invasion!


