#### **Uniform Policy**

Please can I remind everyone of the school's policy on school uniform.

- Children should not be wearing makeup or nail polish to school. Those who do will be asked to remove it.
- Jewellery is also not permitted due to the dangers. Pupils can wear stud earrings only and a watch. Necklaces, bracelets (except medical ones) and other earrings should be kept for the weekend and school holidays.
- School shoes should be black in colour, our policy allows trainers if they are completely black including the soles. Please ensure your child is wearing the correct footwear for school.
- Finally, I am noticing lots of missing ties, this again is an expectation of our uniform policy. Please ensure your child has this for school, those pupils in Year 6 need to get into the habit of having their full unform in preparation for secondary school.

We have worked at improving our mastery of art and design skills in year 4 this week. We worked with partners to create a figure drawing of the human form in any posture.







Head Teacher to Home — 21 April What has happened in Pankhurst Class this this week?




