Measures

nations of coins that equal the same amount. They use standard units of measure (e.g. m, cm, kg, g, °C) to estimate and measure. They tell and write the time to 5 minutes. Children know the number of minutes in an hour and the hours in a day.

Year 1

EYFS - Children learn that objects can be compared and ordered according to their size. They will learn about items being heavy and light. Children begin to use language to describe length and height. They learn to make direct comparisons using language like longer and shorter. They also explore capacity and make comparisons such as more than and less than.

**EYFS** 

Y1 - The children will measure and begin to record lengths and heights. They will continue to use comparative language to solve practical problems like long/short, longer/shorter. They will also measure and begin to record mass/weight, capacity and volume. The children will be able to recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes. Children will be able to sequence events in chronological order using language e.g before and after, next, first, yesterday. They will tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. They will begin to measure and record time.
