Maple have enjoyed a wonderful year of learning and to mark the occasion we held our Leavers Celebration today with some very special visitors.
























Head Teacher to Home - 14 July What has happened in Bevan this week?


# Head Teacher to Home - 21 July What has happened in Drew this week!


























Head Teacher to Home - 21 July What has happened in Pankhurst this week?
